The placement of CanSkate skaters on each session is at the discretion of the Sackville Skating Club.

Our main goal is to have safe, active, and productive sessions for all skaters and therefore skaters may need to be moved to another group/session to ensure this goal is met. The club reserves the right to move skaters to different groups/sessions if necessary.

Registration, including payment, must be received before skaters are permitted on the ice.

The **\$61.65 Skate Canada fee** (valid Sept 2025 to Aug 2026) is non-refundable and must be purchased yearly for every skater on the ice. Fee only charged once per skate season. No refunds except with a medical certificate and a written request to admin@sackvilleskatingclub.com

The number of sessions cannot be guaranteed due to unforeseeable circumstances, such as snow storms. Cancellations will be posted on the club's Facebook page.

Session dates and times are tentative and subject to change. Sessions with low enrollment may be altered and/or canceled.
